The project is generally described as follows:

This project includes the construction of a new fiber optic backbone network and FTTP distribution network in various parts of the City of Champaign. The conduit for the fiber optic cable shall be installed by horizontal directional drilling methods with limited open cut allowed. The project involves the installation of conduit, handholes, manholes, pulling and splicing of fiber optic cable, the installation of Hardened Subscriber Terminals (MST's) and surface restoration. This contract is one of 3 separate contracts being issued simultaneously to construct the UC2B backbone and FTTP network. It is the project expectation that the Contractor(s) selected for each geographic section will coordinate their construction efforts with the Contractor(s) who are chosen to complete the other geographic areas, as specified in the Construction Documents. Coordination and cooperation between Contractors is critical to completion of this project and is required by the contract documents.
