**Position Description:**

UC2B, a partnership between the University of Illinois and the cities of Urbana and Champaign, is leading an effort to install a fiber-optic Internet network that offers fast, high-speed internet access to neighborhoods, businesses and community anchor institutions across Urbana-Champaign. We seek energetic, team-oriented individuals that are familiar with the Urbana-Champaign community and are passionate about helping others to overcome the digital divide. UC2B Community Ambassadors will increase the awareness of UC2B; collect data for research and operational development; and help households, institutions and businesses adopt UC2B Internet service. Qualified candidates will possess the following:

Required Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age at the time of application
- Must pass a criminal background check
- Must attend canvassing training sessions

Qualities and Skills:

- Ability to interact well with community members of all racial, ethnic and socio-economic backgrounds
- Knowledge of Champaign-Urbana neighborhoods and anchor social institutions
- Excellent interpersonal, oral and written communication skills
- Proven organizational skills
- Demonstrated team player
- Basic knowledge of computers and technology
- Flexible work schedule, including evenings and weekends
- Experience with surveys, sales, outreach or similar customer service interactions desired
- Bilingual (Spanish-speaking) candidates desired
- Valid driver's license preferred

Responsibilities:

- Encourage increased knowledge of computerized technology and its relation to the UC2B project
- Carry out multiple survey methods to gain knowledge of community interest, adoption and satisfaction of high-speed broadband internet access
- Conduct face-to-face interviews with residents in assigned areas by following scripted survey questions
- Record the results of broadband surveys through data entry
- Ensure the accuracy, confidentiality and security of survey information at all times
- Prepare survey results for analysis
- Maintain high standards and quality work production
- Provide and seek clear direction and constructive feedback on delegated tasks
- Sustain quality customer service relations with associated households and businesses
- Attend neighborhood meetings or community events to represent UC2B and/or conduct surveys
- Other duties as applicable

Conditions:

- Hours vary by project needs and are not consistent with a standard work schedule. (Example: May work for 2 weeks at a time, for 10-20 hours per week, weeknights and weekends)
- Work will largely be conducted outdoors during various weather conditions
- Frequent walking, standing, and verbal communications required
