WE HAD CANDIDATES FOR VARIOUS OFFICE COME AND TALK TO US... CATHERINE HOGUE WHO RAN FOR COUNTY CLERK. LINDA ABERNATHY WHO RAN FOR COUNTY SUPERVISOR. THE PRESENTATIONS BY THESE CANDIDATES WERE VERY INFORMATIVE.

MARCH WAS WOMEN MONTH. EACH MEMBER WAS TO BRING IN INFORMATION ABOUT HER FAVORITE AFRO-AMERICAN WOMAN. WE HAD MUCH FUN. THIS WAS A VERY ENLIGHTENING MEETING.
